PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Fold large cardboards never use plastic bags. Throw the waste separately.

DO's: newspapers, magazines, leaflets - paper and cardboard packagings (pasta, salt, etc.) small and large carton boxes Tetra Pak cartons (milk, fruit juice - remember to remove the plastic cap)

DON'Ts: dirty paper and cardboard - waxed paper (for food) or plastic-coated paper - baking paper - receipts - carbonless copy paper and similar

GLASS AND METAL

DOs: big and small jars - bottles - drinking glasses - clothes hangers - aluminium caps for bottles and jars - cans for beverages and food - steel containers - aluminium foil

DON'Ts: window and mirror panes - ceramic and porcelain objects - light bulbs and neon tubes - Pyrex glass

PLASTIC

Insert plastic packagings into sealed bags and put them inside the container, reduce the volume, empty and flatten the boxes.

DOs: containers for liquids (soft drinks, water) - bottles for household and personal hygiene products - plastic plates, glasses and cutlery - polystyrene trays - shopping bags - clean yogurt pots - food packagings - polystyrene packagings - bundle straps

DON'Ts: toys - plastic basins - plastic chairs and tables hard plastic (toothbrushes, pens, etc) - dirty plastic - dirty paint cans - any waste that is dirty with dangerous substances (paint, glue, solvents, etc.)

ORGANIC WASTE

Use paper or compostable bags, never use plastic bags

DOs: kitchen waste and food scraps - coffee grounds and tea bags - kitchen paper towels - egg shells - cut flowers and house plants (without topsoil) - perished foods - vegetable and fruit waste - stale bread - pets litter - oily tissues - ashes

DON'Ts: clothes - leather - mown grass - pruned branches - brushwood - topsoil.

MIXED WASTE

Put your waste in a semi-transparent bag

DOs: waste made of various materials (toothbrushes, razor blades, pens waxed or plastic-coated paper, etc.) rags - ceramics - rubbers - plastic basins - nappies and sanitary pads - tape cassettes CDs/DVDs and covers dust vacuum cleaner - broken (non-electronic) toys socks and stockings

DON'Ts: all recyclable materials - bulk or dangerous waste - electronic or electrical devices - light bulbs - batteries - drugs

BULK WASTE

The collection of bulk waste is carried out once a month at home by reservation at the toll-free number 800.615.622.

On the agreed day the material must be placed in front of the indicated house number, and must be arranged in such a way that it can be easily moved by the operators and must not have sharp or protruding parts.
